Competition Award Scoring CVCC Annual Award

Introduction:

This first annual award will be awarded to the Member who has achieved the highest score in Club competitions during the past year. The award will be presented at the final meeting of the Club year.

As there are two competitions that either are announced at the final meeting (Evening Favourites, and London Drugs Print Competition) or held during the summer, the time frame for scoring will run from June 1 of the current year until May 31 of the next club year. ie: June 1, 2022 until May 31, 2023, and so one going forward.

Scoring by Event

Evening Favourites:

In this segment of the total score, all photographs tied for a position will receive the same number of points. ie: If there is a tie for first both images will receive 4 points and so on.

London Drugs Print Competition

Winner	4
Tied for First	3
Entered	2

<u>Note: In the case of the London Drugs Print Competition if there is a tie for first the tie will be broken in the normal manner and the image winning will get the full 4 points the other image or images will be placed second and receive 3 points</u>

CAPA, North Shore, Lions Gate:

As the Club can submit up to six entries into these events the scoring is applied to the six images being forwarded on.

Note: <u>In the event of equal scores for any of the six positions, all images will receive the same</u> <u>score for that position; Members entering will receive one point for entering.</u>

External Awards:

This scoring is based on awards as issued by the External agency and it only applies to members images submitted through CVCC as club entries. The point structure is based on CAPA awards, and will be the principle used should an external agency have a different number of awards. IE: If they only have three awards the scoring will be 3, 2, and 1.

To break a tie for the winning position:

In the event there is a tie at the final stage it will be broken as follows:

- (3) The best Score in the Club Entries in external competitions: If still tied
- (4) The best score in external awards as shown above: If still tied
- (5) Draw from a hat or flip a coin at the last meeting of the year.3
